

Monthly Weather Summary in Thailand

June 2026

In June 2026, Thailand experienced rainfall throughout most of the month due to the influence of a moderate to rather active southwest monsoon prevailing over the Andaman Sea, Thailand, and the Gulf of Thailand throughout the month. This was accompanied by the monsoon trough periodically lying across Myanmar and upper Laos toward the low-pressure cell covering Vietnam almost the entire month. However, the amount and distribution of rain in Thailand were uneven, causing below-normal rainfall in most parts of the country. The average total rainfall in Thailand for this month was approximately 8% below the norm, with most regions reporting below-normal monthly rainfall: the northern region received 19.0 mm (12% of the norm), the northeastern region 61.9 mm (32%), the central region 16.8 mm (11%) and the eastern region 64.4 mm (25%) while rainfall was above normal in southern region (east coast) 5.2 mm (4%) and the southern region (west coast) 142.9 mm (43%). The monthly mean temperature in Thailand was 0.4 °C above the norm.

1 – 10 June: The moderate to rather active southwest monsoon prevailed over the Andaman Sea, Thailand, and the Gulf of Thailand throughout the period. Additionally, the monsoon trough extended over northern, upper central and lower northeastern regions toward the low-pressure cell over the coast of central Vietnam on the first day of the period and the monsoon trough lying across Myanmar and upper northeastern region into the low-pressure cell covering upper Vietnam during the end of the period. Moreover, the low-pressure cell covered upper Myanmar during the middle of the period. As a result, isolated rain in northern region, with heavy rainfall in some areas during the beginning of the period then scattered to fairly widespread rain with heavy to very heavy rainfall in some areas whereas isolated to scattered rain was found in northeastern region except for fairly widespread rain with heavy rainfall in some areas on June 4, 5 and 10. In central region, received isolated to scattered rain with heavy rainfall in some areas except for fairly widespread rain on June 4 and 10 while scattered to fairly widespread rain in eastern regions throughout most of the period with heavy to very heavy rainfall in several areas mainly in the upper portion and in the lower coastal areas. The highest daily rain was 150.0 mm at Amphoe Ban Phaeng in Nakhon Phanom province on June 2 and at Amphoe Sang Khom in Udon Thani on June 10. Gusty winds were reported at Lamphun, Phayao, Udon Thani, Surin, Trat, Chachoengsao and Sa Kaeo provinces. Flood occurred at Mae Hong Son and Chachoengsao provinces on June 3 and at Chiang Rai province on June 7. In southern Thailand, fairly widespread rain was observed along east coast with heavy to very heavy rainfall in some areas during the first half of the period then isolated to scattered rain, fairly widespread rain was found along the west coast with heavy rainfall in several areas and very heavy rainfall in some areas. The highest daily rain was 138.4 mm at Amphoe Kuraburi in Phang-nga province on June 2. Gusty winds were reported at Krabi province on June 4.

11 – 20 June: The moderate southwest monsoon prevailed over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf of Thailand throughout the period. Additionally, the monsoon trough extended over upper northern Thailand and upper Laos during the beginning of the period, moving

towards a low-pressure cell that covered upper Vietnam throughout the period. As a result, scattered to fairly widespread rain in northern region with heavy rainfall in some areas whereas fairly widespread rain was found in northeastern region with heavy rainfall in some areas on the first day of the period then isolated to scattered rain with heavy rainfall in some areas. The central and eastern regions received scattered to fairly widespread rain with heavy rainfall in some areas almost the period and very heavy rainfall in some areas in the lower coastal areas of eastern region. The highest daily rain was 347.0 mm at Phu Kradueng National Park, Phu Kradung in Loei province on June 11. Gusty winds were reported at Chiang Mai on June 12, flash flood at Lamphun province on June 14. In Southern Thailand, there were scattered to fairly widespread rain almost the period with heavy rainfall in some areas. The highest daily rain was 168.4 mm at Amphoe Takua Thung in Phang-nga province on June 11. Flash flood occurred at Trang province on June 10, Surat Thani province on June 11, Krabi and Phang-nga provinces on June 10 and 11.

21 – 30 June: The moderate southwest monsoon, which prevailed over the Andaman Sea, Thailand, and the Gulf of Thailand, strengthened at the end of the period. Additionally, the monsoon trough extended over Myanmar and upper Laos during this period, moving towards a low-pressure cell that covered the upper Vietnam almost the period. As a result, isolated to scattered rain in northern and northeastern regions during the beginning and the middle of the period then fairly widespread rain with heavy to very heavy rainfall in some areas. The central and eastern regions received isolated to scattered rain with heavy rainfall in some areas except for central region experienced fairly widespread rain with heavy rainfall in some areas on June 21 and 28. The highest daily rain was 111.5 mm at Amphoe Rattanawapi in Nong Khai province on June 29. Gusty winds were reported at Buriram and Uthai Thani provinces on June 25, at Samut Sakhon, Rayong and Bangkok provinces on June 26. In Southern Thailand, there was isolated to scattered rain along east coast except for fairly widespread rain with heavy to very heavy rainfall in some areas on June 28 and 30, fairly widespread rainfall was observed along the west coast with heavy to very heavy rainfall in some areas during the end of the period. The highest daily rain was 138.5 mm at Amphoe Takua Pa in Phang-nga province on June 28.
