<p>Weather Forecast: During 15 – 16 Sep, the monsoon trough lies across the lower North, the Central, the East and the lower Northeast into the active low pressure cell over the South China Sea while the southwest monsoon prevails over the Andaman Sea, the South and the Gulf with isolated heavy rains are likely in the lower Northeast, the Central including Bangkok and vicinity and the South. The moderated wind and waves in the upper Andaman Sea are likely 1 - 2 meters high, about 1 meter high in the lower Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf and above 2 meters high in thundershowers.</p> <p>During 17 – 21 Sep, the monsoon trough lie across the lower North, the Central, the East and the lower Northeast while the southwest monsoon prevailing over the Andaman Sea, the South and the Gulf will strengthen. Isolated heavy rains are likely in the country while isolated very heavy rains are possible in the East and the South (west coast). The moderate wind and waves in the upper Andaman Sea are likely about 2 meters high, 1 - 2 meters high in the lower Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf and above 2 meters high in thundershowers.</p> <p>In addition, an active low-pressure cell over the South China Sea is expected to move closer to the coast of Vietnam.</p>			
<p>Warning: During 17 – 19 Sep, people in the East and the South (west coast) should beware of heavy to very heavy rains and its accumulation that may cause flash flood and overflows, especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">All ships in the Andaman Sea and the Gulf should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers throughout the period.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">North</p>	<p>Scattered thundershowers throughout the period and isolated heavy rains. Variable winds 5 – 15 km/hr. Minimum temperature 22 – 25 °C. Maximum temperature 30 – 35 °C.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">North eastern</p>	<p>During 15 – 16 Sep, scattered thundershowers mostly in the lower part. During 17 – 21 Sep, scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains mostly in the lower part. Variable winds 10 – 15 km/hr. Minimum temperature 22 – 25°C. Maximum temperature 31 – 35 °C.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">Central</p>	<p>Scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains throughout the period. Variable winds 10 – 15 km/hr. Minimum temperature 22 – 25 °C. Maximum temperature 31 – 34 °C.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">Eastern</p>	<p>During 15 – 16 Sep, scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains. Variable winds 15 – 30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers. During 17 – 21 Sep, fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rains during 17 – 19 Sep. Variable winds 15 – 35 km/hr. Wave height 1 - 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 23 – 28 °C. Maximum temperature 29 – 34 °C.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">Southern (East Coast)</p>	<p>Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rains throughout the period. During 15 – 16 Sep, southwesterly winds 15 – 30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers. During 17 – 21 Sep, southwesterly winds 15 – 35 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter, 1 - 2 meters offshore and above 2 meters in thundershowers Minimum temperature 23 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 31 – 34 °C.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">Southern (West Coast)</p>	<p>scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain throughout the period. Isolated very heavy rains during 17 – 19 Sep. During 15 – 16 Sep, Krabi upward: southwesterly winds 15 – 35 km/hr. Wave height 1 - 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Trang downward: southwesterly winds 15 – 30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers. During 17 – 21 Sep, Phang Nga upward: southwesterly winds 20 – 35 km/hr. Wave height about 2 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Phuket downward: southwesterly winds 15 – 35 km/hr. Wave height 1 - 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 22 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 28 – 33 °C.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">Bangkok Metropolitan Region</p>	<p>Scattered to fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains throughout the period. Variable winds 10 – 15 km/hr. Minimum temperature 24 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 31 – 33 °C.</p>		
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
