

	Weather Forecast Division Thai Meteorological Department	Medium Range Forecasts Weather Outlook During 1 - 7 Dec 2025	
Weather Forecast: During 1 – 3 Dec, the high-pressure system from China covering upper Thailand and the South China Sea is weakening with an increase in temperature and morning fog. Morning cool to cold is forecast in the North and the Northeast while cool in the morning is forecast in the Central including Bangkok and vicinity, the East and the upper South regions. The northeast monsoon prevailing over the Gulf, the South and the Andaman Sea is weakening with less rains and isolated thundershowers. The wind and waves in the Gulf and the Andaman Sea are expected about 1 meter high and above 1 meter high in thundershowers. During 4 – 7 Dec, the easterly wave will move pass the Gulf, the South and the Andaman Sea with more rains and isolated heavy rains in the South. The strengthening wind forces the waves in the Gulf and the Andaman Sea offshore up to be 1 - 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. Another moderate high-pressure system from China will extend to the Northeast and the South China Sea leading to the easterly waves will move covers the lower Northeast, the East, the Central including Bangkok and its vicinity and the lower North with isolated rains/thundershowers. Cool to cold weather is likely in the North and the Northeast while cool in the morning is likely in the rest regions except for the lower South. In addition, tropical storm “KOTO” over the middle South China Sea is expected to move near the coast of the Southern Vietnam during 1 – 2 Dec while the high-pressure system covers Vietnam and the South China Sea. This storm will decline rapidly and not move to Thailand but leading to the easterly wind prevailing over upper Thailand will strengthen. Warning: People in the upper country and the upper South should keep healthy due to cool to cold weather and variable weathers including beware of fire due to dry air throughout the period. During 1 – 3 Dec, all transport take more caution in poor visibility. During 4 – 7 Dec, People in the upper country and the upper South should beware thundershower and accumulated rain. Farmer should prevent for crop's damage. All ships in the Gulf and the Andaman Sea should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers throughout the period.			
The weather forecast is valid from Monday this week until Sunday next week			
North	Morning cool to cold with fog and 3 – 5 °C rise in temperature throughout the period. During 5 – 7 Dec, isolated rains mostly in lower part. Minimum temperature 12 – 22 °C. Maximum temperature 27 – 33 °C. Cold to very cold on the mountain top. Minimum temperature 4 - 15 °C. During 1 – 4 Dec, variable winds 10 – 15 km/hr. During 5 – 7 Dec, easterly winds 10 – 20 km/hr.		
North eastern	During 1 – 3 Dec, morning cool to cold with light fog and 2 – 4 °C rise in temperature. During 4 – 7 Dec, isolated rains mostly in lower part. Cool to cold with morning light fog. Minimum temperature 15 – 23 °C. Maximum temperature 29 – 33 °C. Cool to cold on the mountain top. Minimum temperature 8 - 16 °C. During 1 – 3 Dec, variable winds 10 – 15 km/hr. During 4 – 7 Dec, northeasterly winds 10 – 25 km/hr.		
Central	Morning cool with light fog and 3 – 5 °C rise in temperature throughout the period. During 5 – 7 Dec, isolated rains/thundershowers. Minimum temperature 16 – 24 °C. Maximum temperature 29 – 34 °C. During 1 – 4 Dec, variable winds 10 – 15 km/hr. During 5 – 7 Dec, easterly winds 10 – 25 km/hr.		
Eastern	Morning cool with light fog and 3 – 5 °C rise in temperature throughout the period. During 5 – 7 Dec, isolated to scattered rains/thundershowers. Minimum temperature 18 – 25 °C. Maximum temperature 29 – 34 °C. During 1 – 3 Dec, northeasterly winds 15 – 30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter. During 4 – 7 Dec, southeasterly winds 15 – 30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers.		
Southern (East Coast)	During 1 – 4 Dec, upper part: morning cool and 3 – 5 °C rise in temperature. Lower part: isolated thundershowers. Northwesterly winds 15 – 30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 1 meters in thundershowers. During 5 – 7 Dec, scattered to fairly widespread thundershower and isolated heavy rains. Easterly winds 15 – 35 km/hr. Wave height 1 - 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 18 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 29 – 34 °C.		
Southern (West Coast)	During 1 – 4 Dec, isolated light rains. Northwesterly winds 15 – 30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meters and above 1 meters offshore. During 5 – 7 Dec, scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rains. Easterly winds 15 – 30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meters, above 1 meter offshore and above 2 meters in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 22 – 26 °C. Maximum temperature 30 – 34 °C.		
Bangkok Metropolitan Region	Morning cool with light fog and 2 – 4 °C rise in temperature throughout the period. During 5 – 7 Dec, isolated rains/thundershowers. Minimum temperature 20 – 25 °C. Maximum temperature 30 – 34 °C. During 1 – 4 Dec, variable winds 10 – 15 km/hr. During 5 – 7 Dec, southeasterly winds 10 – 25 km/hr.
