**Medium Range Forecasts**  
**Weather Outlook During 6 – 12 May 2026**



**Weather Forecast:** During 7 – 9 May 2026, more thundershowers and gusty winds are in the upper country because the high-pressure system from China will cover the South China Sea with strengthen easterly and southeasterly wind prevail across the upper country while there are hot weather. During 10 - 12 May 2026, thundershowers still present in the upper country with gusty winds in some areas because the high-pressure system which cover the South China Sea and the Northeast is weak while the southwesterly and the southeasterly winds prevails across the upper country.

For the South, during 6 – 12 May 2026, the easterly wind prevail across the South with more rains and isolated heavy rains. The winds and waves in the Gulf are expected about 1 meter high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers.

**Warning:** During 7 - 9 May 2026, people in the upper country should beware of severe conditions by keeping off outdoor places, big trees and unsecured billboards. Farmers should prevent for crop damage and animals danger and keep healthy due to change weather **throughout the period.**

During 8 – 9 May 2026, people in the lower South should beware of heavy rain and accumulation that may cause flash floods and overflows especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands.

**The weather forecast is valid from Wednesday this week until Tuesday next week**

<b>North</b>	<p>During 7 - 10 May 2026, day hot and scattered thundershowers with gust and hail. Isolated heavy rain during 8 – 9 May. Southeasterly winds 5 - 15 km/hr. Minimum temperature 21 - 27 °C. Maximum temperature 32 - 39 °C.</p> <p>During 11 - 12 May 2026, isolated thundershowers with gust. Southerly winds 5 - 15 km/hr. Minimum temperature 20 - 26 °C. Maximum temperature 31 - 35 °C.</p>
<b>Northeastern</b>	<p>During 7 - 9 May 2026, day hot and scattered thundershowers with gust. Isolated heavy rain during 8 – 9 May. Southeasterly winds 10 –20 km/hr. Minimum temperature 22 - 26 °C. Maximum temperature 29 – 37 °C.</p> <p>During 10 - 12 May 2026, isolated thundershowers with gust. Southerly winds 10 –15 km/hr. Minimum temperature 22 - 27 °C. Maximum temperature 31 – 36 °C.</p>
<b>Central</b>	<p>During 7 - 9 May 2026, day hot and isolated to scattered thundershowers with gust. Isolated heavy rain during 8 – 9 May. Southeasterly winds 10 - 20 km/hr. Minimum temperature 24 - 28 °C. Maximum temperature 34 - 38 °C.</p> <p>During 10 – 12 May 2026, isolated thundershowers with gust. Southerly winds 10 - 20 km/hr. Minimum temperature 24 - 27 °C. Maximum temperature 32 - 35 °C.</p>
<b>Eastern</b>	<p>During 7 - 9 May 2026, scattered thundershowers with gust. Isolated heavy rain during 7 – 8 May. During 10 - 12 May 2026, isolated thundershowers with gust. Southeasterly winds 10 - 30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 1 meter in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 24 - 28 °C. Maximum temperature 33 - 37 °C.</p>
<b>Southern (East Coast)</b>	<p>During 6 - 12 May 2026, scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rains during 8 – 9 May. Easterly winds 15 - 30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meter in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 23 - 27 °C. Maximum temperature 33 - 39 °C.</p>
<b>Southern (West Coast)</b>	<p>During 6 - 12 May 2026, scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rains during 8 – 9 May. Easterly winds 15 - 30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meter in thundershowers. Minimum temperature 24 - 28 °C. Maximum temperature 33 - 37 °C.</p>
<b>Bangkok Metropolitan Region</b>	<p>During 7 - 9 May 2026, day hot and scattered thundershowers with gust. Isolated heavy rain during 8 - 9 May. Southeasterly winds 10 - 20 km/hr. Minimum temperature 26 - 29 °C. Maximum temperature 34 - 37 °C.</p> <p>During 10 - 12 May 2026, isolated thundershowers with gust. Southerly winds 10 - 20 km/hr. Minimum temperature 25 - 27 °C. Maximum temperature 32 - 35 °C.</p>
