**Daily Weather Forecast Distribution
On Sunday 19 May 2024
Time Issued 0500 LST**

General Situation

The southwesterly winds prevails over the upper Thailand and hot weather during the day are likely in the whole areas. while the low-pressure cell covers the upper Vietnam. Thundershowers with gusty wind are likely in the upper country and isolated heavy rain are possible in the North, the lower Central and the East regions. People in the upper country should beware of severe conditions. The Southweterly winds covers the Gulf, the South and the Andaman Sea while the low-pressure cell covers Sumatra Island with isolated heavy rains in the South. People in the South should beware of the severe conditions.

In addition during 20–23 May 2024, the southwesterly wind prevailing over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf will strengthen while **during 22–26 May 2024**, the low-pressure cell covers the Gulf of Martaban, Myanmar. More rains and isolated heavy rains are likely in the country while isolated very heavy rains are possible in the western part of the North and the Central and the South (west coast). People should beware of the severe conditions that may cause flash floods and overflows, especially, along waterways and lowlands, and take more caution in thundershowers. The strengthening wind and waves are likely 2-3 meters high in the upper Andaman Sea and above 3 meters in thundershowers, the waves in the lower Andaman Sea and the lower Gulf about 2 meters high and more than 2 meters high in thundershowers while the waves in the Gulf are likely about 1 meter high, 1-2 meters offshore and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. All ships should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers. The boats in the upper Andaman Sea keep ashore. Please stay tuned for the weather update.

Weather Forecast for Thailand from 6.00 a.m. Sunday to 6.00 a.m. Monday

<u>North</u>	Day hot. Scattered thundershowers with gusty wind and isolated heavy rain in Mae Hong Son, Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Phrae, Nan, Lamphun, Lampang, Uttaradit, Tak, Kamphaeng Phet, and Phetchabun. Minimum temperature 24-28 °C. Maximum temperature 35-39 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-15 km/hr.
<u>Northeast</u>	Day hot. Scattered thundershowers with gusty wind mostly in Loei, Nong Khai, Bueng Kan, Sakon Nakhon, Nakhon Phanom, Chaiyaphum, Amnat Charoen, Nakhon Ratchasima, Buriram, Surin, Sisaket and Ubon Ratchathani. Minimum temperature 23-27 °C. Maximum temperature 33-37 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km/hr.
<u>Central</u>	Day hot. Scattered thundershowers with gusty wind and isolated heavy rains in Nakhon Sawan, Uthai Thani, Lopburi, Saraburi, Suphanburi, Phra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya, Kanchanaburi, Ratchaburi, Nakhon Pathom, Samut Sakhon and Samut Songkhram. Minimum temperature 25-27 °C. Maximum temperature 35-38 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-25 km/hr.
<u>East</u>	Scattered thundershowers with gusty wind and isolated heavy rains in Prachinburi, Sa Kaeo, Chachoengsao, Chonburi, Rayong, Chanthaburi and Trat. Minimum temperature 24-27 °C. Maximum temperature 32-37 °C. Southwesterly winds 15-30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters high in thundershowers.
<u>South, east coast</u>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rains in Phetchaburi, Chumphon, Surat Thani, Nakhon Si Thammarat, Phatthalung, Songkhla, Pattani, Yala and Narathiwat. Minimum temperature 23-27 °C. Maximum temperature 32-36 °C. Southwesterly winds 15-30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and offshore, above 2 meters high in thundershowers.
<u>South, west coast</u>	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rains in Ranong, Phang Nga, Phuket, Krabi, Trang and Satun. Minimum temperature 24-26 °C. Maximum temperature 32-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 15-30 km/hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters high in thundershowers.
<u>Bangkok and vicinity</u>	Scattered thundershowers with gusty wind. Minimum temperature 26-28 °C. Maximum temperature 33-36 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-30 km/hr.
