Daily Weather Forecast Distribution

On Monday 1 September 2025

Time Issued 2300 LST

General Situation

The monsoon through lies across the lower North the Central and the Northeast while rather strong the southwest monsoon prevailing over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf. Isolated heavy rain are likely in Thailand while isolated very heavy rain are possible in the East and the South regions (west coast). People in these areas should beware of heavy to very heavy rain and its accumulation that may cause flash floods and overflows especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands.

The rather strong wind forces the waves in the upper Andaman Sea up to 2-3 meters high and above 3 meters high in thundershowers. In the lower Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf, the waves are likely about 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. All ships should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers, small boats in the upper Andaman Sea should keep ashore until 3 September 2025.

Weather Forecast for Thailand from Monday midnight to Tuesday midnight

North	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Mae Hong Son, Chiang Mai, Lamphun, Lampang, Phrae, Uttaradit, Sukhothai, Tak, Kamphaeng Phet, Phitsanulok, Phichit and Phetchabun. Minimum temperature 23-25 °C, maximum temperature 30-34 °C. Variable winds at 10-20 km/hr.
Northeast	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Loei, Nong Bua Lamphu, Chaiyaphum, Nakhon Ratchasima, Khon Kaen, Kalasin, Mukdahan, Maha Sarakham, Roi Et, Yasothon, Amnat Charoen, Buriram, Surin, Sisaket and Ubon Ratchathani. Minimum temperature 22-25 °C, maximum temperature 31-34 °C. Variable winds at 10-30 km/hr.
Central	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Lopburi, Phra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya, Saraburi, Kanchanaburi and Ratchaburi. Minimum temperature 24-26 °C Maximum temperature 34-36 °C Southwesterly winds 10-20 km/hr.
East	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rain in Nakhon Nayok, Prachinburi, Chachoengsao, Rayong, Chanthaburi and Trat. Minimum temperature 24-26 °C Maximum temperature 31-35 °C Southwesterly winds 20-35 km/hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
South, east coast	Scattered thundershowers mostly in Phetchaburi, Prachuap Khiri Khan, Chumphon, Surat Thani and Nakhon Si Thammarat. Minimum temperature 23-25 °C, maximum temperature 33-35 °C. Southwesterly winds, 20-35 km/hr. Wave height 1-2 meters, about 2 meters offshore and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
South, west coast	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rain in Ranong, Phang Nga and Phuket. Minimum temperature 24-28 °C, maximum temperature 30-35 °C. From Phuket northwards: Southwesterly winds 20-40 km/hr. Wave height 2-3 meters, above 3 meters in thundershowers. From Krabi southwards: Southwesterly winds 20-35 km/hr. Wave height about 2 meters, above 2 meters in thundershowers.
Bangkok and vicinity	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain. Minimum temperature 25-26 °C, maximum temperature 34-36 °C. Southwesterly winds, 10-20 km/hr.

On Monday : Maximum temperature at 1.20 p.m. 34.9 °C
On Tuesday : Maximum temperature 36 °C Minimum temperature 25 °C
