Daily Weather Forecast Distribution Monday 1 December 2025 Issued at 1700 LST

General Situation

The rather strong high-pressure system from China covering upper Thailand, the upper South and the South China Sea is weakening with an increase in temperature and morning fog. Morning cool to cold is forecast in the upper country. People in the upper country and the upper South should keep healthy due to variable weathers including beware of fire due to dry air.

The northeast monsoon prevailing over the Gulf, the South and the Andaman Sea is weakening with isolated rain. The wind and waves in the Gulf and the Andaman Sea are expected about 1 meter high and above 1 meter high in thundershowers. All ships should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers.

In addition, tropical storm "KOTO" over the South China Sea was down grade to the tropical depression and will move near the coast of Vietnam during 1-2 Dec 2025. While the high-pressure system covers Vietnam and the upper South China Sea. This strom is not move to Thailand.

Northeasterly winds 15-30 km/hr.
Wave height about 1 meter.
Cool with morning light fog and slightly rise in temperature in the upper part.
Isolated rains/thundershowers in the lower part mostly in Pattani, Yala and Narathiwat.
Minimum temperature: 18-23 °C Maximum temperature: 30-32 °C
Northwesterly winds 15-30 km/ hr.
Wave height about 1 meter and above 1 meter in thundershowers.
Morning cool. Isolated light rain mostly in the lower part.
Minimum temperature: 21-23 °C Maximum temperature: 31-33 °C.
Northwesterly winds 15-30 km/hr.
Wave height about 1 meter and above 1 meter offshore.
Cool with morning light fog and 1-2 °C rise in temperature.
Minimum temperature: 20-22 °C Maximum temperature: 31-33 °C
Variable winds 10–15 km/hr.

On Monday : Maximum temperature at 3.06 p.m. 33.6 $^{\circ}$ C On Tuesday : Maximum temperature 33 °C Minimum temperature 20 ℃ : Sunrise at 6.26 a.m. Sunset at 5.47 p.m. : High water at 5.11 a.m. and at 2.28 p.m. : Low water at 8.00 a.m. and at 11.37 p.m.
