Daily Weather Forecast Distribution

Monday 29 June 2026

Issued at 2300 LST

General Situation

The moderate southwest monsoon prevailing over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf is strengthening while the monsoon through lies across upper Myanmar and upper Laos into the low-pressure cell over upper Vietnam. More rains and isolated heavy rains are forecast in Thailand and isolated very heavy rains are possible in the East and the South (west coast) regions. People in the country should beware of heavy to very heavy rains and accumulation that may cause flash floods, overflows and landslides especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands.

The rather strong wind force the waves in the upper Andaman Sea up to be 2-3 meters high and above 3 meters high in thundershowers. In the lower Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf, the waves are expected about 2 meters high and above 2 meters high in thundershowers. All ships in the Andaman Sea and the Gulf should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers, small boats in the upper Andaman Sea should keep ashore.

Weather Forecast for Thailand from Monday midnight to Tuesday midnight

North	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Mae Hong Son, Chiang Rai, Phayao, Nan, Uttaradit, Tak, Phitsanulok and Phetchabun. Minimum temperature 23-28 °C. Maximum temperature 32-36 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
Northeast	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Loei, Nong Khai, Bueng Kan, Udon Thani, Sakon Nakhon, Nakhon Phanom, Mukdahan, Yasothon, Amnat Charoen and Ubon Ratchathani. Minimum temperature 24-26 °C. Maximum temperature 31-36 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
Central	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Nakhon Sawan, Lop Buri, Saraburi, Phra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya, Kanchanaburi, Ratchaburi, Nakhon Pathom and Samut Sakhon. Minimum temperature 24-26 °C. Maximum temperature 34-36 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
East	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rain in Nakhon Nayok, Prachin Buri, Sa Kaeo, Chachoengsao, Rayong, Chanthaburi and Trat. Minimum temperature 24-28 °C. Maximum temperature 30-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 20-35 km./hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
South, east coast	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Chumphon, Surat Thani, Nakhon Si Thammarat, Phatthalung, Yala and Narathiwat. Minimum temperature 23-26 °C. Maximum temperature 33-35 °C. From Surat Thani northward: Southwesterly winds 20-35 km./hr. Wave height 1-2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershower and offshore. From Nakhon Si Thammarat southward: Southwesterly winds 15-30 km./hr. Wave height about 1 meter and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
South, west coast	Fairly widespread thundershowers and isolated heavy to very heavy rain in Ranong, Phang Nga, Phuket, Krabi, Trang and Satun. Minimum temperature 22-24 °C. Maximum temperature 29-33 °C. From Phang Nga northward: Southwesterly winds 20-40 km./hr. Wave height 2-3 meters and above 3 meters in thundershowers. From Phuket southward: Southwesterly winds 20-35 km./hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
Bangkok and vicinity	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain. Minimum temperature 25-27 °C. Maximum temperature 33-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
