Daily Weather Forecast Distribution

Sunday 9 August 2026

Issued at 1700 LST

General Situation

The monsoon trough lies across the upper North and upper Laos while the rather strong southwest monsoon prevails over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf. Isolated heavy rains are forecast in the North, the Northeast, the Central and the East regions. People should beware of heavy rains and accumulation that may cause flash floods, overflows and landslides especially along the waterways near foothills and lowlands.

The rather strong winds force the waves in the upper Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf up to be 2-3 meters high and above 3 meters high in thundershowers. All ships should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers, small boats in the upper Andaman Sea and the upper Gulf should keep ashore.

In addition, typhoon "DOLPHIN" over the East China Sea is forecast to make landfall over Zhejiang, China by tonight (9 Aug 2026). This storm will not move into Thailand. Travelers should check the weather forecast for the region they are going to be visiting.

Weather Forecast for Thailand from to 6.00 p.m. Sunday to 6.00 p.m. Monday

North	Fairly widespread thundershowers and heavy rain in Mae Hong Son, Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Lampang, Phayao, Nan, Phrae, Uttaradit, Tak, Phitsanulok and Phetchabun. Minimum temperature 23-28 °C. Maximum temperature 31-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
Northeast	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Nong Khai, Bueng Kan, Udon Thani, Sakon Nakhon, Yasothon, Mukdahan, Amnat Charoen, Nakhon Ratchasima and Ubon Ratchathani. Isolated very heavy rain in Nakhon Phanom. Minimum temperature 25-26 °C. Maximum temperature 30-33 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
Central	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Lop Buri, Saraburi and Kanchanaburi. Minimum temperature 23-26 °C. Maximum temperature 33-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-25 km./hr.
East	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Nakhon Nayok, Prachin Buri, Chanthaburi and Trat. Minimum temperature 25-26 °C. Maximum temperature 31-34 °C. Southwesterly winds 20-40 km./hr. Wave height 2-3 meters and above 3 meters in thundershowers.
South, east coast	Isolated thundershowers mostly in Phetchaburi, Prachuap Khiri Khan, Chumphon, Yala and Narathiwat. Minimum temperature 22-26 °C. Maximum temperature 33-36 °C. Southwesterly winds 20-35 km./hr. Wave height 1-2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers and offshore.
South, west coast	Isolated thundershowers mostly in Ranong, Phang Nga, Trang and Satun. Minimum temperature 24-27 °C. Maximum temperature 32-35 °C. From Phuket northward: Southwesterly winds 20-40 km./hr. Wave height 2-3 meters and above 3 meters in thundershowers. From Krabi southward: Southwesterly winds 20-35 km./hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
Bangkok and vicinity	Scattered thundershowers. Minimum temperature 24-27 °C. Maximum temperature 34-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-25 km./hr.
