Daily Weather Forecast Distribution

Thursday 13 August 2026

Issued at 1700 LST

General Situation

The monsoon trough lies across Myanmar, upper Laos and upper Vietnam while the rather strong southwest monsoon prevails over the Andaman Sea, Thailand and the Gulf with isolated heavy rains in the North, the upper Northeast, the Central and the East regions. People in the areas should beware of heavy rains and accumulation that may cause flash floods, overflows and landslides especially along the waterways near foothills lowlands including overbank flow in the Northeast.

The rather strong winds force the waves in the upper Andaman Sea up to be 2-3 meters high and above 3 meters high in thundershowers. All ships should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers, small boats in the upper Andaman Sea should keep ashore.

Weather Forecast for Thailand from 6.00 p.m. Thursday to 6.00 p.m. Friday

<u>North</u>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Mae Hong Son, Nan, and Tak. Minimum temperature 23-27 °C. Maximum temperature 32-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
<u>Northeast</u>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Bueng Kan, Sakon Nakhon, Nakhon Phanom, and Mukdahan. Minimum temperature 24-26 °C. Maximum temperature 33-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-20 km./hr.
<u>Central</u>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Saraburi and Kanchanaburi. Minimum temperature 24-27 °C. Maximum temperature 33-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-25 km./hr.
<u>East</u>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain in Nakhon Nayok, Prachin Buri, Chanthaburi, and Trat. Minimum temperature 24-28 °C. Maximum temperature 31-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 20-35 km./hr. Wave height about 2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<u>South, east coast</u>	Scattered thundershowers mostly in Chumphon, Surat Thani, and Nakhon Si Thammarat. Minimum temperature 23-26 °C. Maximum temperature 33-36 °C. Southwesterly winds 20-35 km./hr. Wave height 1-2 meters, about 2 meters offshore, and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<u>South, west coast</u>	Scattered thundershowers mostly in Ranong, Phang Nga, and Phuket. Minimum temperature 23-26 °C. Maximum temperature 32-35 °C. From Phang Nga northward: Southwesterly winds 20-40 km./hr. Wave height 2-3 meters and above 3 meters in thundershowers. From Phuket southward: Southwesterly winds 15-35 km./hr. Wave height 1-2 meters and above 2 meters in thundershowers.
<u>Bangkok and vicinity</u>	Scattered thundershowers and isolated heavy rain. Minimum temperature 26-27 °C. Maximum temperature 34-35 °C. Southwesterly winds 10-25 km./hr.
