



Weather outlook for Thailand during Rainy Season (June - October 2012)

General Condition

During the period June to October 2012, are expected to receive normal to below normal rainfall especially southern Thailand. However, northern and northeastern parts of Thailand are expected to receive slightly above normal rainfall in some areas in early period.

The tropical storms 1 - 2 tropical cyclones to pass Thailand is expected, There are high probability that some tropical cyclones will move through Vietnam and pass the upper Thailand during August or September, and pass southern Thailand during October or November

- Warning The effect of tropical storms such as windy, widespread rainfall with heavy to very heavy falls then the flooding conditions, the sea wave height 3-5 meters in the Gulf of Thailand and the Andaman Sea, and storm surge over the coastal areas may occur, the people and navigators should be cautious from natural disaster and follow the weather news from Meteorological Department.

Methodology

Using statistical and other climate prediction schemes, the climate scientists determined likelihoods of above-normal, normal and below-normal rainfall for each area. The scientists also took into account that neutral El Nino-Southern Oscillation (ENSO) phase is projected to persist into early 2012.
